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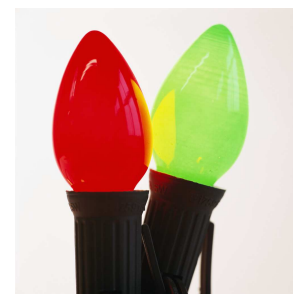
Fourth Annual Christmas Flotilla Parade Coming

Group Information

We have received numerous requests in the office about group functions at the resort. Questions have ranged from a couple of hours to all-day reunion events and about everything from Birthdays to Weddings, so we wanted to share our Group Reservation information with you in case you may be interested renting the pavilion for your group needs

- First and foremost we DO NOT rent out the pool or playground for private parties. The pool & playground will stay open to ALL resort guests during operating hours.
- Group Event Reservations can only be done if you are a member or overnight guest of Caney Creek RV Resort & Marina. In other

words we do not allow groups to rent the pavilion without having an RV Site or Boat Slip rented the day of the event.

- The Pavilion Charge is \$40 per hour (2-hour minimum) or \$200 for the day (8-hours max). This will include up to 25 guests free of charge. Each additional guest will be charged \$6 per person up to 50 guests maximum.
- Group events can start no earlier than 8AM or run no later than 10PM.
- Shared use of the pool & playground is included with the pavilion rental.
- ALL GUESTS MUST PARK IN THE GRAVEL LOT AND BE SHUTTLED TO/FROM

THE PAVILION. A shuttle can be provided for an additional fee through a third party vendor.

- A final Guest list must be provided to the Front Desk prior to the event.
- A contract will have to be signed and insurance requirements must be met in order to reserve the event (i.e. food vendor and responsible vendor insurance, etc).
- Once the event is over ALL guests must leave the resort. Any hold-over will result in additional charges to the event organizer.
- Additional information is available by calling the office and asking for a manager.

How do I go about renting the Pavilion for my Group?

Resort Parking Policy

Parking: We have contracted with local towing companies to help remove mis-parked and unauthorized RV's, vehicles, boats and trailers from the resort. To avoid being towed at your expense please follow these simple, but very important guidelines:

***Get a current vehicle and/or boat parking pass** (max of 2). Having No Pass or Expired Pass means you will be towed at your expense!

***No Parking in the Road.** Please be sure your entire RV & vehicle are on your site. If you stick out onto the road you must park in the gravel lot.

***Park in your designated site & slip only. DO NOT PARK** in any other site or slip, but your own. This is the main reason we tow. Why? You have no idea what site/slip has been rented for the night and just because it is empty does not mean its open. Please

park on your site/slip or in the Gravel Parking lot or you will be towed at your expense.

***No Boat or utility trailers are allowed past the Gravel Lot.** We charge a daily fee for every boat entering the resort in or out of the water. Please see the office for current rates. All registered boats & trailers must have a parking decal affixed.

***All Visitors MUST park in designated parking spaces** near the Bath House or Pool. Once those are filled they must park in the Gravel Lot across from the check in building or they will be towed.

***DO NOT PARK ON THE ROAD, GRASS, GOLF CART PARKING, OR ANY OTHER SITE BUT YOUR OWN!**

Guests: All Guests MUST be registered at the front desk prior to entering the resort to get a daily parking pass. Guests

are required to park in the auxiliary parking spaces or Gravel Lot (not empty sites!). Fees for guests are assigned as follows:
\$6 for Adults / \$3 for Children.

These fees apply for every Guest over 4 per site, **not to exceed 8 people total per site.** Guests must leave the resort by 10PM.

Please Note: Your site rate is based on 4 people. However the following courtesy has been extended to the following members:

6-month members are allowed 2 additional Guests at no extra charge. (6 total)

Annual members are allowed 4 additional Guests at no extra charge. (8 total)

Remember the total number of people allowed per site is eight (8) maximum.

In all cases, every visitor must sign in prior to entry to receive a daily parking pass.

Resort Nighttime Hosts

Caney Creek RV Resort & Marina has provided our Guests with a Nighttime Resort Check-In & Security Host. This host is responsible for Emergencies, After-Hour Check-ins, Parking assistance to sites and Parking Enforcement within the resort.

It has come to my attention that a couple of our Members and their Guests have

disregarded the warnings from the resort host for parking in the road or even someone else's site. Some of our Guests & Members have even swore at our Hosts or threatened to do physical harm for simply doing the job assigned to them.

Let me be clear... Anyone found to be in violation of our resort policies will be

asked to modify their behavior to meet those policies whether it's parking, number of guests, noise control, whatever.

Anyone who gives our resort hosts or ANY employee a hard time about it or threatens a member of my team will be **EVICTED** immediately from this Resort and Marina.

I don't care if your parking in someone else spot for just a minute. It's not your spot so stay out of it! You agreed to this by entering into the Resort.

If you have a problem with any of my employees call me, I'll listen, but do not approach my staff! I encourage you to contact me with any questions. Thank you. - Rob

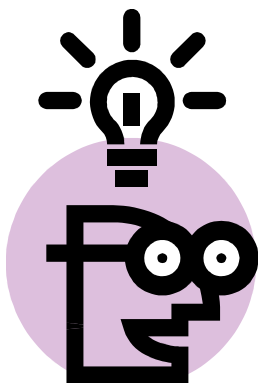
Summertime Activities...What a Blast!
